RICHFIELD LIVING EXPANSION MILESTONES



Richfield Living embarked on two large scale expansion projects at their Salem and Roanoke, Virginia campuses. At the Salem campus, Phase I is complete which included constructing a new rehabilitation building, Town Center, and two Independent Living buildings. In Roanoke, a new Health Center provides the household model of care for 116 new resident rooms with public spaces. The Salem campus Phase II Independent Living expansion will commence in the fall, with ARCH serving as the construction monitor.
